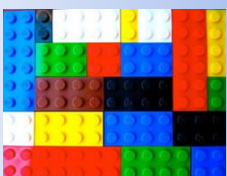

## Procedure

Visualising, structuring, classifying– these are the classic fields of application for mind maps. We want to shift the focus more to a scaffolding activity.

### **Before class**

1. Prepare a mind map with **gaps** featuring key vocabulary from a text or topic.

### **In class**

2. Invite your learners to fill the missing words in the gaps. They can work in pairs or on their own.

## Tip

The missing words in the mind map can be provided in a separate word box.

## Alternative

The method also works well for **revision**. In this case do not provide a word box.
