Choice of statements (C1)

- 1. Because our population is at seven billion people and continues to grow, we need to expand land area available for living and growing food by cutting down the rain forest.

- 3. In order to feed our population, we must use pesticides, chemical fertilizers, and genetically modified crops to increase farm yields.
