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Procedure

Categorising for Revision

- 1. Provide your learners with a subject-related word list.
- 2. Tell them to come up with 3 (or 4) categories of their own choice to categorise the terms given.
- 3. They list the terms in their 3 categories.
- 4. (Scaffold functional "negotiating language" if necessary. See 'Functional Language')
- 5. Then they explain their choice of category and lists to a partner.

Alternative 1

Clustering and Categorising

- 1. Provide your learners with a subject-related word list.
- 2. Work in pairs.
- 3. Cluster the terms that go together.
- 4. Write them in a column.
- 5. Find a headword.

Alternative 2

Categorising and Writing

- 1. Provide your learners with a subject-related word list (including separate parts of collocations/word chunks).
- 2. Underline the terms that ... (subject-related subcategories) in red and the terms that... in green.
- 3. Match the terms with the verbs to form suitable collocations.
- 4. Form meaningful, subject-related sentences.
