# Thinking skills LOTS or HOTS

### **Procedure**

Visualising, structuring, classifying – these are the classic fields of application for mind maps. We want to shift the focus more to a scaffolding activity.

### **Before class**

1. Prepare a mind map with gaps featuring key vocabulary from a text

#### In class

2. Invite your learners to fill the missing words in the gaps. They can work in pairs or on their own.

## **Tip**

The missing words in the mind map can be provided in a separate word box.

### **Alternative**

The method also works well for **revision**. In this case do not provide a word box.
