

## The Hot Seat

## Level

Intermediateadvanced

## Procedure

1. Form groups of four learners. They all have to write down three questions related to the current unit of study. Tell them to write the questions on three separate slips of paper. Set a time limit.
2. Seat each group in a circle. Tell them which is the hot seat (e.g. by counting 1-4 with 1 being the hot seat). Tell them to sit on their question slips (literally).
3. The learner sitting on the hot seat starts. He/she takes out his/her question slips and hands one to each of his/her three partners.
4. He/she is asked to answer his/her own questions, which his/her partners will now take turns to ask him/her.
5. When the first learner has answered all his/her questions, the learner to his right sits on the hot seat.
6. Repeat steps 3-5 till every group member has sat on the hot seat once.

Tip
This activity is excellent for the revision of a unit or a topic.

## Alternative

Also suitable for pair work.
