10 Facts you should know about the Ukraine

1) Ukraine is called ''**The bread basket of Europe**''. The country's fertile (fruchtbaren/fertile) black soil (Boden/suolo=terra) was responsible for producing more than a quarter of the Soviet Union's grain, vegetables, milk and meat.

2) Russians are the second largest ethnic group in the Ukraine.

3) The currency (bank notes and coins) are called **hryvnya**. In medieval times this was the currency used by **Kievan Rus**, the kingdom that is considered to be the birthplace of modern Russia. It has been the currency of modern Ukraine since September 1996

4) Ukraine's **Chornobyl power plant** became the site of one of the world's worst nuclear disasters when a reactor exploded there in 1986. To limit the impact of the catastrophe, a special "exclusion zone" of 30 kilometers has been in place around the plant ever since.

5) Ukraine has a great amount of iron and other minerals for the production of metal.

6) A famous traditional song is "Oi Khodyt Son Kolo Vikon" ("A Dream Passes by the Windows").

7) Kyiv's Arsenalaya subway station is the deepest subway station (105.5 meters) in the world.

8) Ukrainians are extremely **superstitious** (abergläubisch/superstiziosi). If you do something that they believe can be bad for you such as sitting on stone steps, someone will tell you that you should not do it.

9) Ukrainians are extremely **generous** and **hospitable**. All social occasions include food. Visitors are always offered something to eat as well as a beverage. It is considered the height of rudeness to eat in front of another person and not offer them something.

10) The typical greeting is a warm, firm handshake, maintaining direct eye contact, and repeating your name.
